

Tell me about a time when you felt especially proud of some members or leaders of your congregation? First thing that comes to mind is the Kelly family, Mike and Kristen and their gift and commitment to fostering children. It takes very special people to step up and make this kind of commitment. They inspire the rest of us to do more. Next up is this congregations response to crisis big or small, in-house or out. There's not one incident; it's all of them.

Are you happy to be here? Why did you join this congregation instead of another one? Some people choose based on size, others on style (traditional and/or contemporary), others on the Pastors. We give high marks on all the above, but first and foremost are the people we've come to know. We have a whole new family of friends in the congregation and office and have never experienced this kind of fellowship at a church.

How has being part of this congregation helped you and members of your family grow in faith? The various bible studies have certainly contributed, but the one that has had the most impact on Michael is the Men's Bible Study on Tuesday mornings. They have a core group and have gotten to know each other, shared life's experiences and grown closer. All these guys have had a big influence on him.

Mary grew up in a different faith that she describes as rule focused. Like Michael said, the studies are formative but the personal relationships that Westminster fosters are incredible. This environment is helping her develop a more personal relationship with Christ.

What have you especially valued about your pastors and other congregational staff? As an office volunteer and exposure to the day-to-day, Michael has a tremendous appreciation now of what it takes to make a church work week in and week out. The work and preparation for each week is eye opening. The music and sermons alone which we take for granted, take a lot of time and talent and that's before we talk about the pastoral care by Jeff and Suzi that we would venture most members never hear about. Throw in the administrative requirements to run an office, constant communication material, and the Bible study programs and you begin to understand why we used the word 'tremendous' when we began this paragraph. Mary appreciates the focus on God's calling for Westminster. Many people don't realize how much time the staff spends in prayer and studies focused on the Holy Spirit's will for us.

2019 CAPITAL CAMPAIGN






WHERE TO GO?

WHAT IS ALPHA?...

Happy New Year!!!! I am so excited about 2019 and what God is going to do here at Westminster. You are going to hear me say in-reach and outreach a lot this year. The goal is to not only minister to those in our church, but to reach those outside our walls. This isn't easy to do, and we are going to rejoice over one person at a time.

This Spring I am setting the ground work for that by offering a class called Alpha. This class is perfect for us to do in-reach and outreach.

What I love about Alpha is that when you lead it you don't have to answer any questions. In fact you aren't supposed to answer questions. It is set up for people to explore and ask and discuss questions together, but the leader is not supposed to answer questions. This helps anyone who doesn't feel confident to answer the questions, but has a heart to share the gospel and wants to reach people for Christ in their neighborhood, family, or friend circles to be able to lead without fear. He or she just facilitates the conversation.

We will have two different classes this spring. You can go to either our Sunday night class from 5:45-7:15 or our Wednesday night class from 6:00-7:30. Jeff is leading the Sunday night and I am leading the Wednesday night. There will be a meal with fellowship, a video and then discussion. Each group will only have 8-12 people. We can have more than one group meeting at the same time, so there is no limit on how many people can sign up. A powerful part of Alpha is the extended worship/Holy Spirit day. On Saturday March 2nd we will bring both Sunday and Wednesday night groups together to have an amazing morning of worship, learning about the Holy Spirit, and an opportunity for healing prayer.

My prayer is in the fall we will have some groups happening in people's homes, at the Gables, maybe even at Tanglewood Middle school after school (Alpha has a youth study). I already have a couple interested in hosting in their home. You could put it on your Nextdoor website to invite people and see what God does with that... If you are even a tiny bit interested, please come and experience Alpha this spring, you could even invite a friend and take it together. This is something new and different for Westminster, but I am praying our church family can get on board and make Alpha through Westminster a place for transformation in 2019. 
